

This garden, set within the woodland of the Wentworth estate, was remodelled to suit the requirements of a young family with plenty of space for play and entertainment.


Set on steeply sloping land the terracing allowed for levelled lawn areas and a series of summer flowering meadows. The swimming pool terrace was expanded for summer entertainment and planted with scented billowing masses of grasses, Roses, Salvia, Ceanothus and Verbena.

Pleached Hornbeam trees help to shape and define the outdoor spaces giving that architectural connection to the house.

The planting relaxes into a woodland meadow and stream planted with tree ferns and the prehistoric looking giant, Gunnera manicata. A tree house for children's parties and peaceful relaxation is nestled amongst the Magnolia and Birch trees.
